

“The Queensland Triathlon” travel trade competition

TERMS & CONDITIONS

By submitting an entry, each entrant is deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions.

1. Anyone may play the Queensland Triathlon game, however competition prizes may only be won by Eligible Participants. An Eligible Participant is a UK resident, aged 18 or over who works in front line sales in the travel industry. Employees of Tourism and Events Queensland, Hills Balfour, TTG, Etihad, Destination Gold Coast, Visit Sunshine Coast or family members are not Eligible Participants. Verification of identity, proof of employment and date of birth will be required upon acceptance of a prize.
2. To enter the competition and have the opportunity to win prizes, entrants are required to play the “Queensland Triathlon Travel Trade Competition” by visiting the competition website, <http://www.goforgoldinqueensland.com> and completing the Queensland Triathlon game and quizzes between Thursday 4 April 06.00am to Thursday 31 May 2018 23.59pm GMT.
3. Entries that are received after the competition closing date 31 May 2018 at 23.59pm GMT will not be eligible.
4. In order to be eligible to win one of the major prizes, entrants must have completed and passed the basic level quiz of each of the four competition partners and played all three sport games. Winners will then be drawn at random from the top 100 entrants on the leaderboard at competition end.
5. The major prizes consist of **nine places on a familiarisation trip to Queensland, Australia** travelling before the end of June 2019. The prize includes return flights to Queensland from London Heathrow, plus minimum eight nights on the ground in destination visiting the Gold Coast, Sunshine Coast and the Great Barrier Reef. Detailed itinerary and travel dates will not be available until a later date, but will include all accommodation, touring, most meals, domestic flights and international flights with Etihad Airways. Any other incidental expenses are not included and must be paid for by the winners. The Promoter will have no liability in relation to travel costs associated with travelling to or from the departure airport.
6. The Minor prizes consist of:
 - (i) **weekly goodie bags** – each week for eight consecutive weeks, the player in the number one position on the leaderboard will receive a Queensland “goodie bag”. If the same entrant is in the lead position for more than one week during the competition period, the prize will automatically be allocated to the next highest scoring entrant. The weekly winner will be selected based on their ranking as at midnight each week for the following dates: Wed 11, 18, 25 April and 2, 9, 16, 23 and 30 May.
 - (ii) **250 Commonwealth Games Borobi mascots** – to be eligible to win one of these prizes, entrants must have completed and passed at least one quiz and completed all three of the sporting “Queensland Triathlon” games. For each quiz completed, the entrant will have an additional entry in the random draw. Winners will be drawn at random on 1 June 2018 and notified by 15 June 2018.
7. The nine familiarisation trip winners will be notified by email and follow-up phone call using the contact details provided at registration on Thursday 14 June 2018 by 23.59pm GMT. The winners must respond and accept the prize by Friday 29 June 12.01pm GMT by replying in writing to the notification email. If a winner does not confirm their intention to claim the prize within this

timeframe, a replacement winner will be selected from the remaining entries at the Promoter's discretion.

8. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any variation in the prize advertised and the prize provided. All expenses outside of the stated prizes are at the cost and responsibility of the winners. It is the responsibility of the major prize winners to ensure they have a valid passport and travel visa. Travel insurance is not provided and the Promoter recommends the prize winners obtain comprehensive travel insurance including medical coverage prior to travel.
9. The Prizes are supplied as is, and are not transferable, exchangeable, redeemable for cash and cannot be sold.
10. Each entrant releases and indemnifies the Promoter and agencies associated with the competition against all liability, cost, loss or expense arising out of acceptance of any prize or participation in the competition including (but not limited to) personal injury and damage to property and whether direct or consequential.
11. By entering the competition, entrants accept that the Promoter will be capturing personal information including name, date of birth, address, and email address. Entrants accept that the Promoter and all parties associated with the promotion may use their name, contact details and likeness for their promotional and publicity purposes without the payment of any fee.

Entrants may opt-in to being subscribed to the databases of Tourism and Events Queensland and Etihad Airways for their online marketing and promotional communications, using the details that the entrant has supplied on its entry form. Entrants who opt-in consent to their name and email address being used for this purpose.

In the event of a dispute over who submitted an entry, the authorised subscriber of the email account used to participate in the competition at the actual time of entry will be deemed to be the entrant.
